

EARLY ADVENTURE

An introductory social skills program for children aged 6 to 8

Led by licensed therapists, the Early Adventure program at the Casa Colina Children's Services Center is an introductory social skills program for children with autism and other developmental disabilities. Early Adventure gives participants access to age-appropriate activities that help them to make improvements in social skills, play skills, and peer interactions. Program levels consist of one-hour weekly sessions that focus on:

- ◆ Personal space
- ◆ Sharing and turn-taking
- ◆ Basic conversation skills
- ◆ Engaging in group activities with peers
- ◆ Social greetings and farewells



Groups are small (usually 3-5 children) and are led by two instructors specializing in speech-language pathology, occupational therapy, or early intervention.

All sessions take place at the Children's Services Center (Building 10) on our Pomona campus. Please call the number below for more information.
