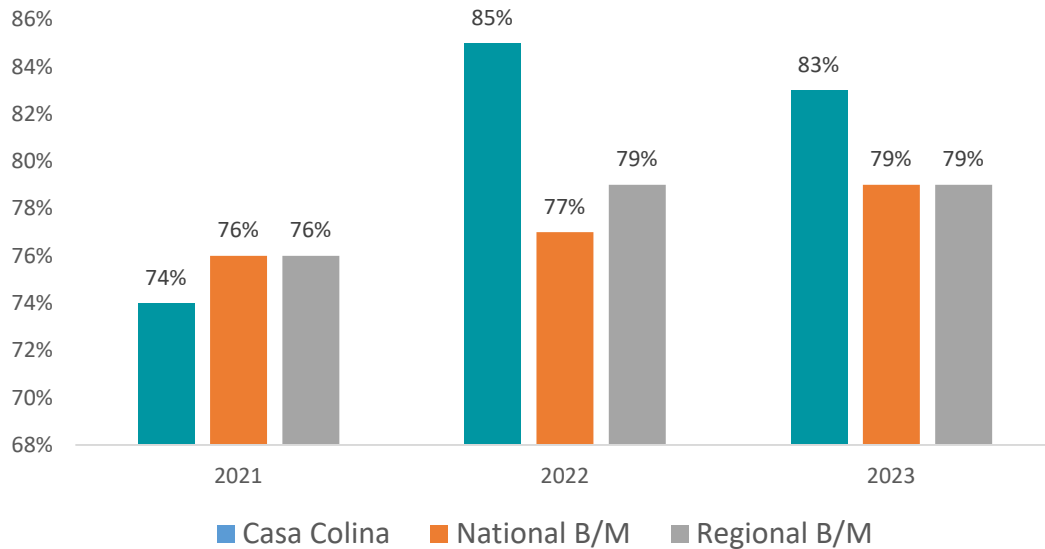

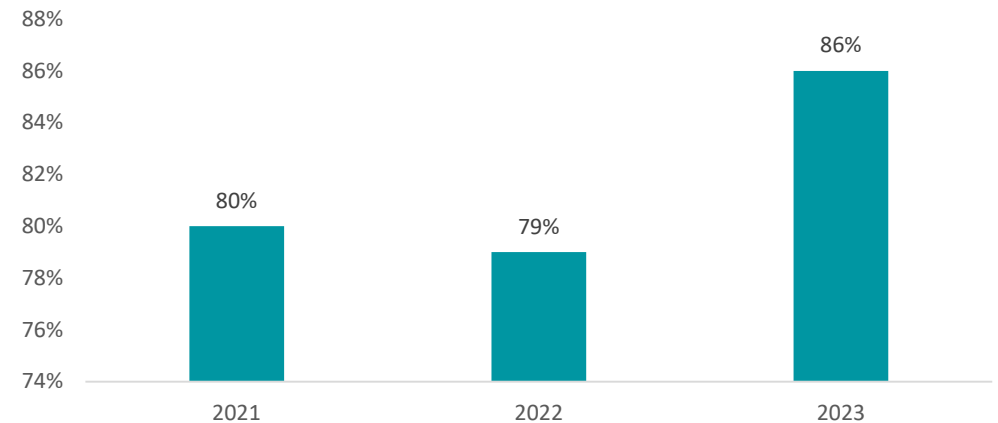
Brain Injury: Community Discharge



82% of inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge

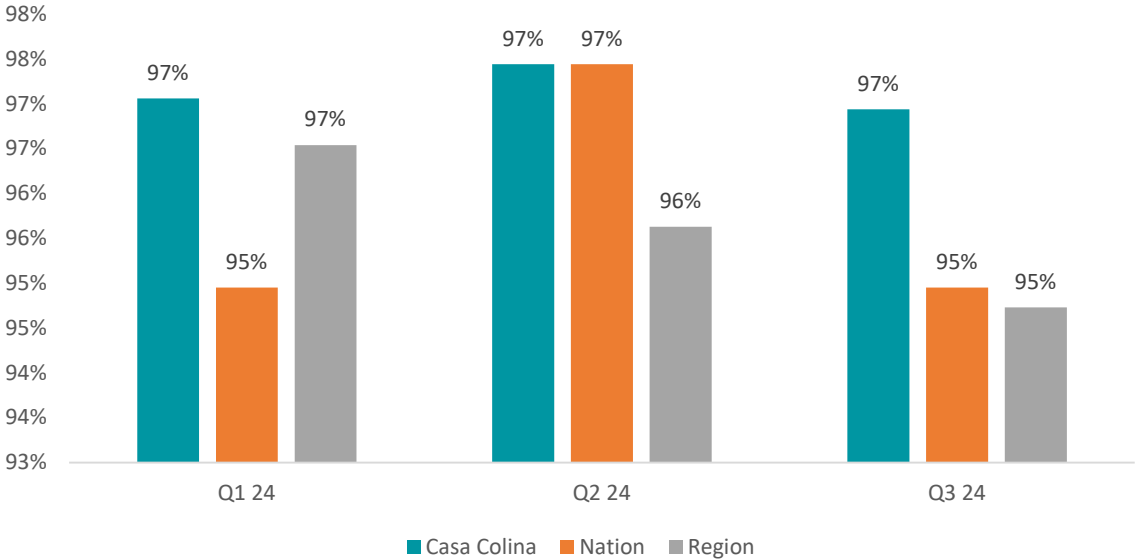

Brain Injury: Remain in Community at 3 Months

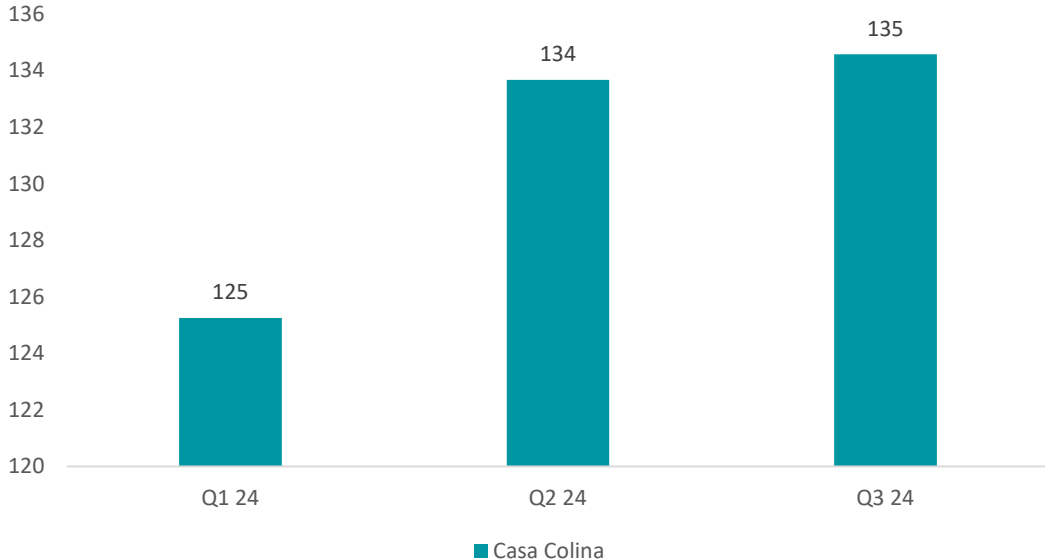


Casa Colina provides an average of 131 minutes of therapy per day; 97% individual minutes for persons with Brain Injury

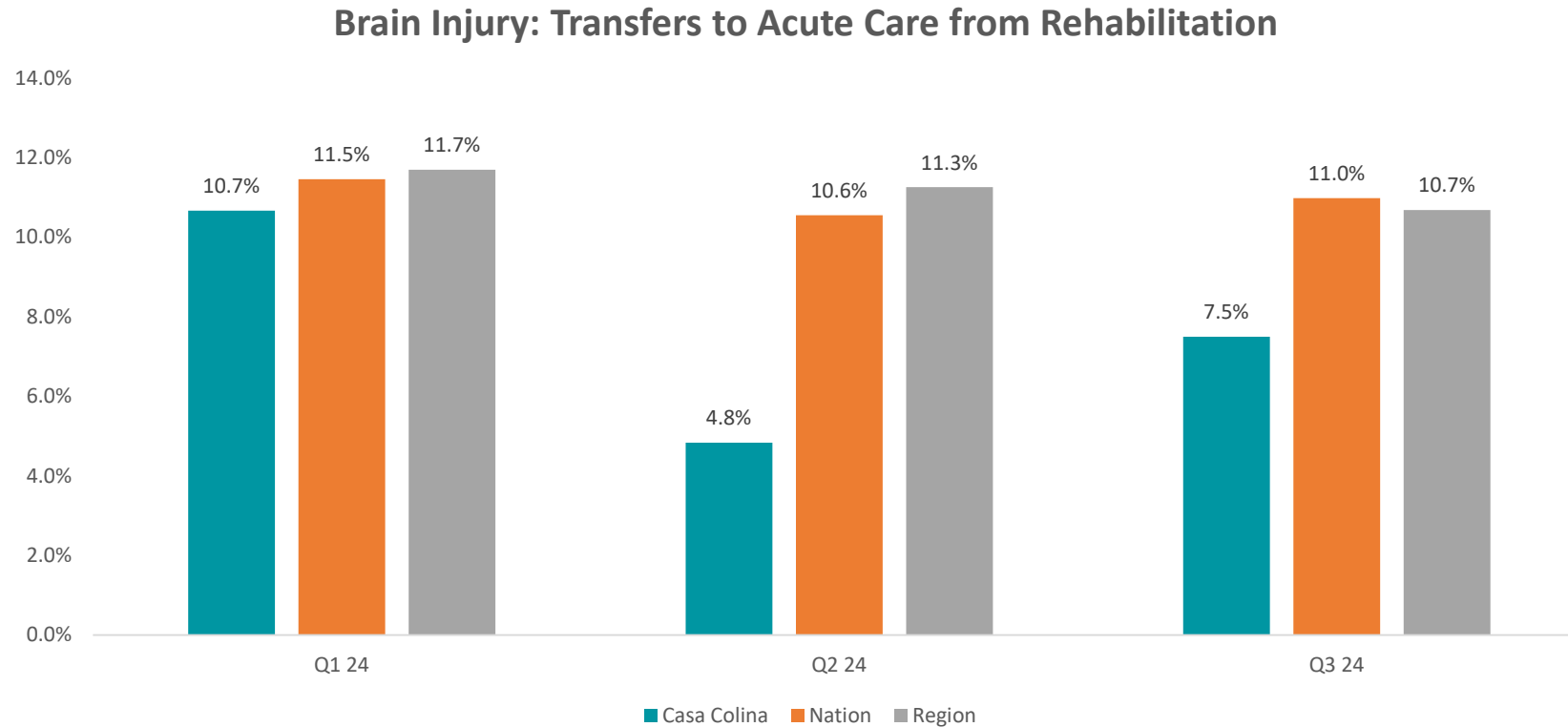
Brain Injury: Individual Therapy Minutes Per Day

Patient Outcomes 2023

(3 months post discharge)

Over 76% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge

Patients with a brain injury were satisfied or highly satisfied with these aspects of care:	2023
Overall satisfaction with their rehabilitation stay	98%
Social activities are the same or better than before their rehabilitation stay	76%
Decision making during their rehabilitation stay	87%
Rehabilitation prepared patients to return home	93%
Progress made met expectations	92%
Rehabilitation program improved their quality of life	94%
