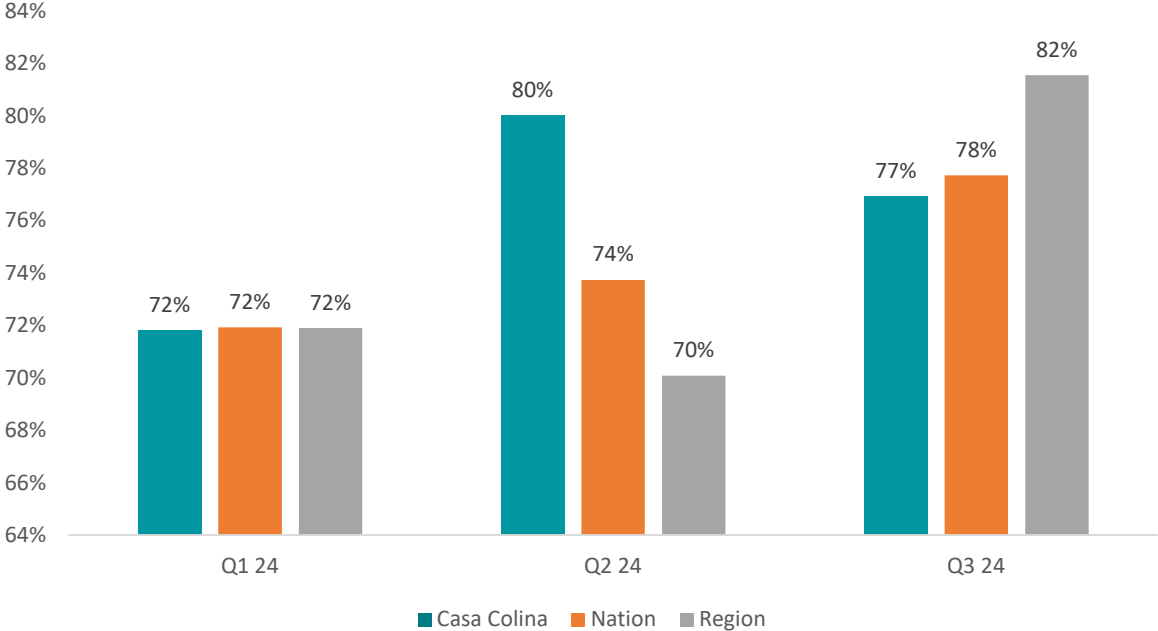

Patients with a Spinal Cord Injury receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge

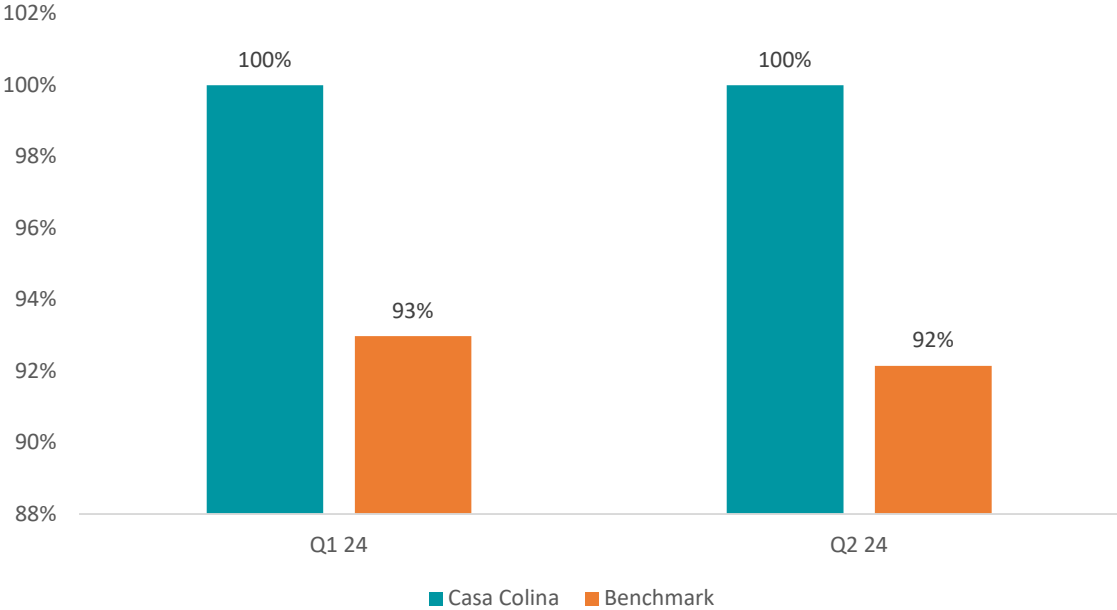
76% of inpatients return to the community at discharge

Spinal Cord Injury: Community Discharge



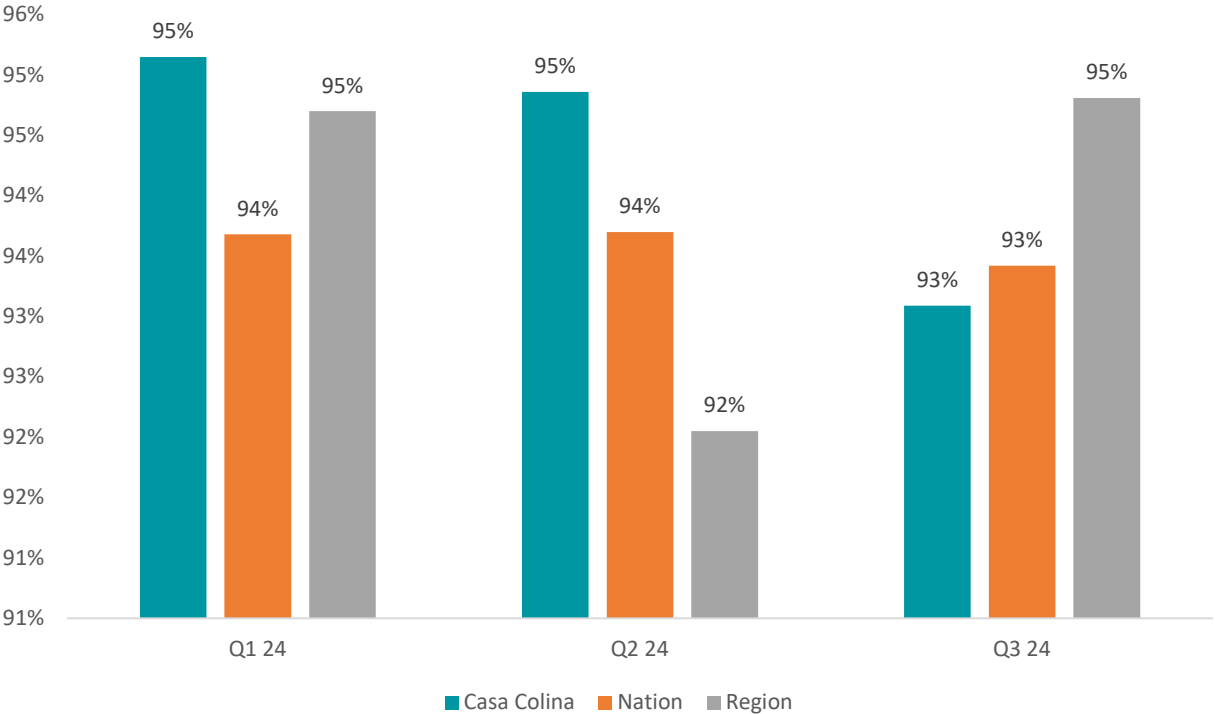
100% of inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge

SCI: Remain in Community @ 3 months

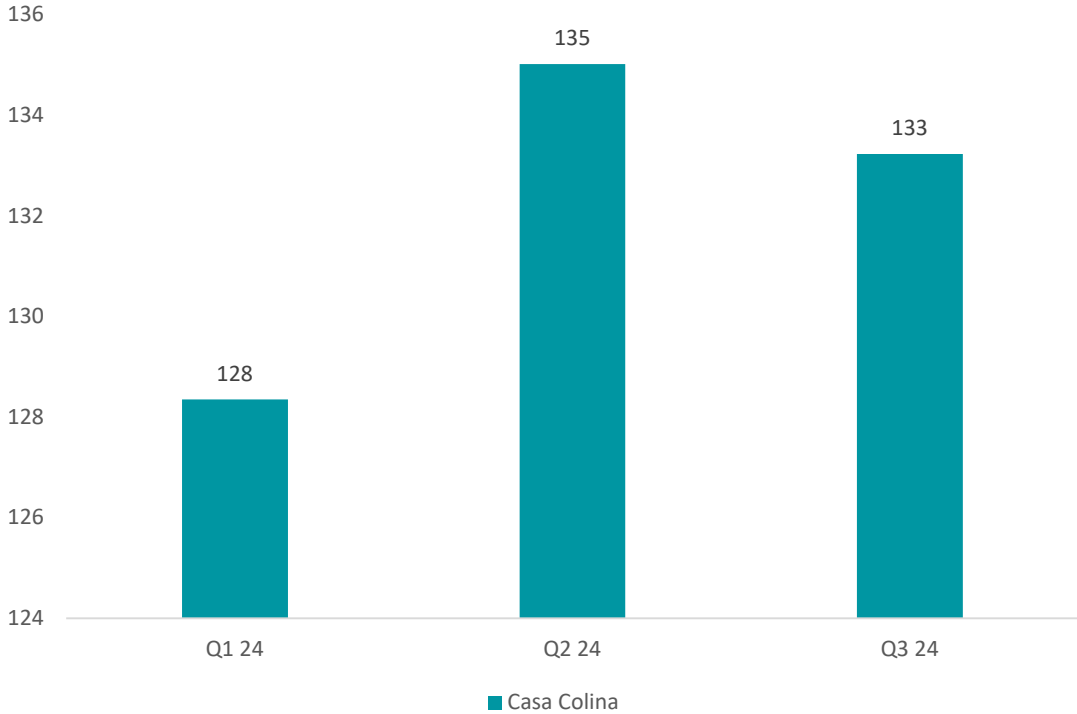


Casa Colina provides an average of 132 minutes of therapy per day; 94% individual minutes for persons with Spinal Cord Injury

SCI: Individual Therapy Minutes Per Day

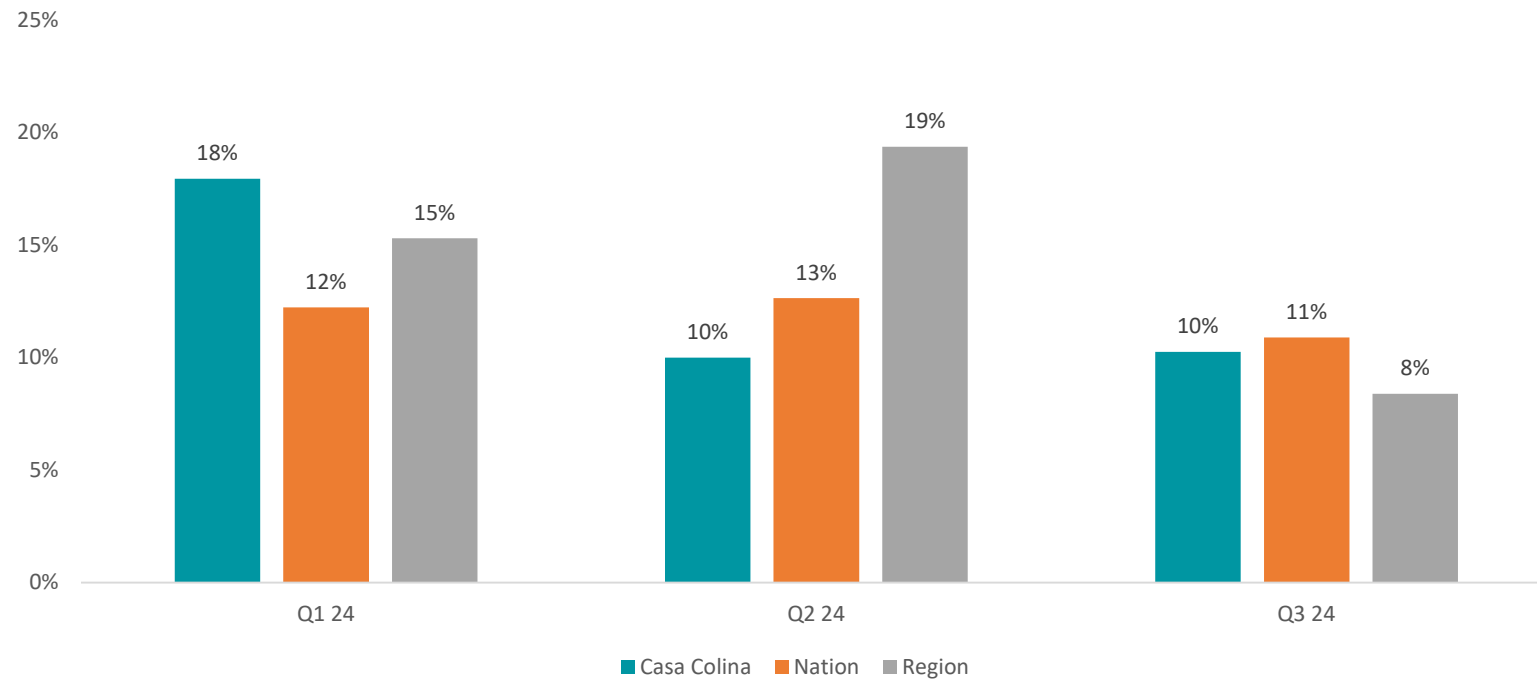


SCI: Total Therapy Minutes Per Day



Casa Colina transfers 15% of patients with Spinal Cord Injury out for acute medical care; similar to other programs in the nation

Patient Outcomes 2024

(3 months post discharge)

Over 75% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge
