

Patients with a Stroke receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge


Over 80% of inpatients return to the community at discharge

Over 90% of inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge


Stroke: Remain in the Community @ 3 months






Casa Colina provides an average of 133 minutes of therapy per day; 97% individual minutes for persons with Stroke






Stroke: Total Therapy Minutes Per Day
