

Patients with a Spinal Cord Injury receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge


76% of inpatients return to the community at discharge

97% of inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge






Casa Colina provides an average of 132 minutes of therapy per day; 94% individual minutes for persons with Spinal Cord Injury

Over 80% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge
