

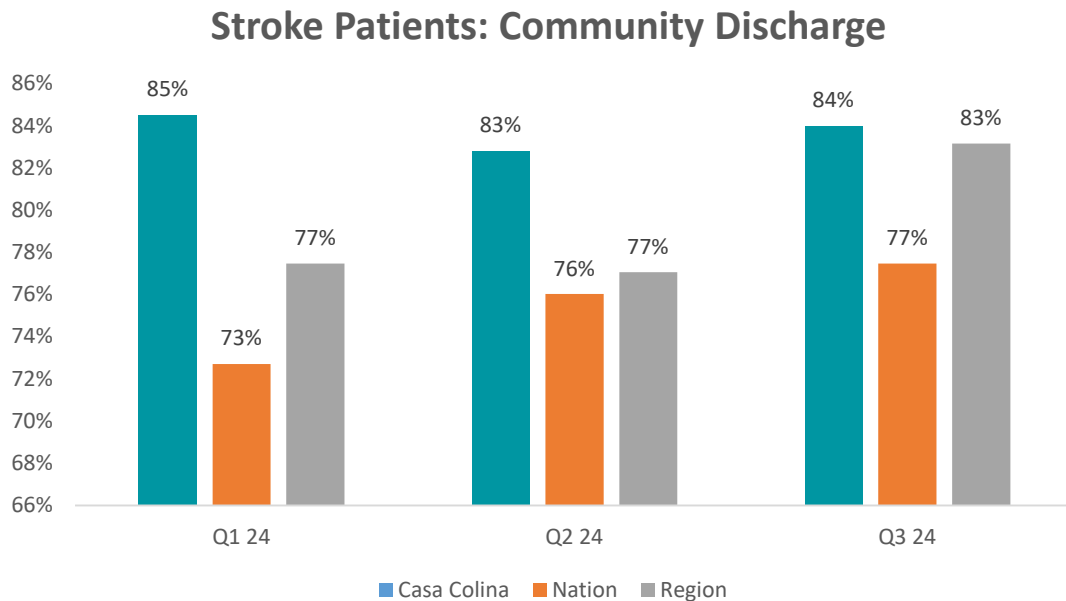

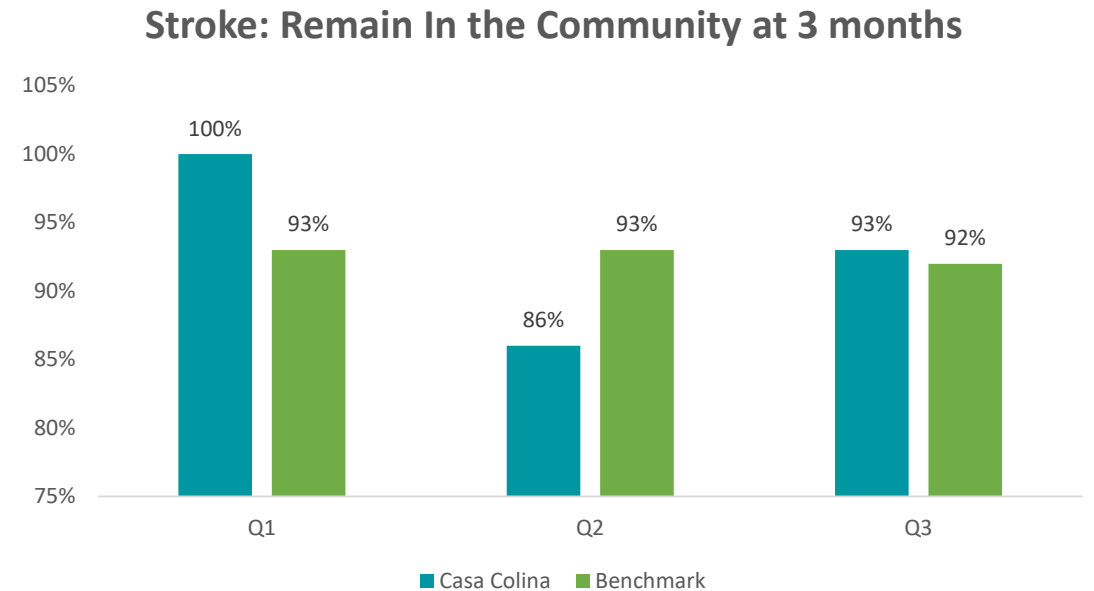

Patients with a Stroke receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge

Over 80% of inpatients return to the community at discharge

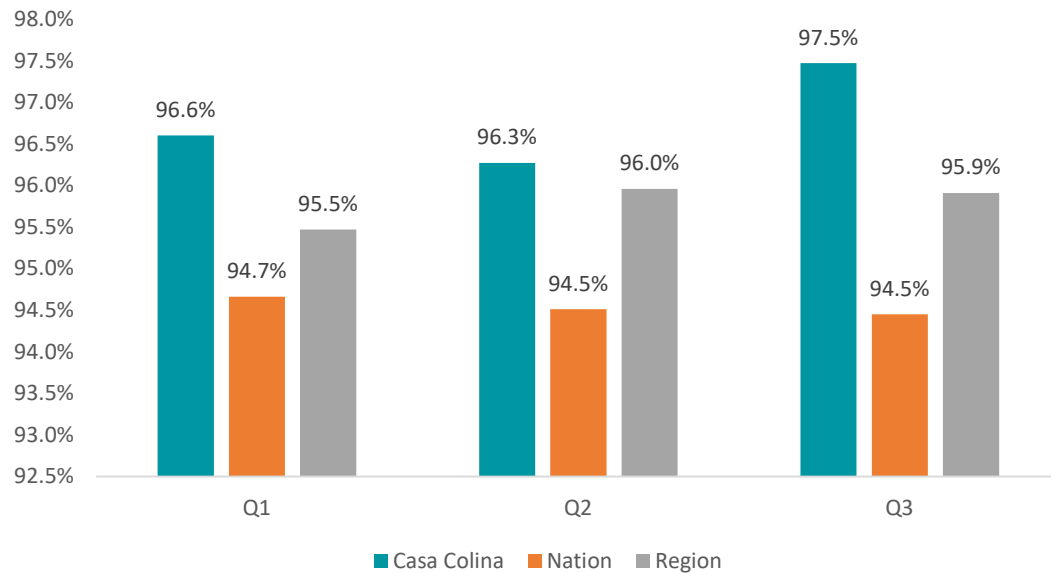


Over 90% of inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge

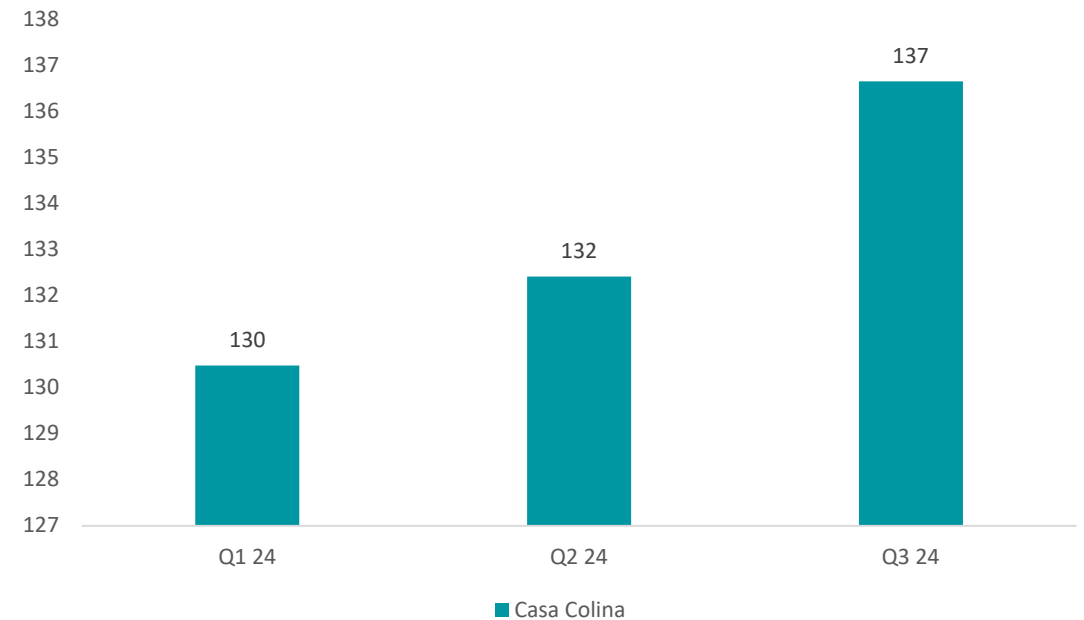


Casa Colina provides an average of 133 minutes of therapy per day; 97% individual minutes for persons with Stroke

Stroke: Individual Therapy Minutes Per Day

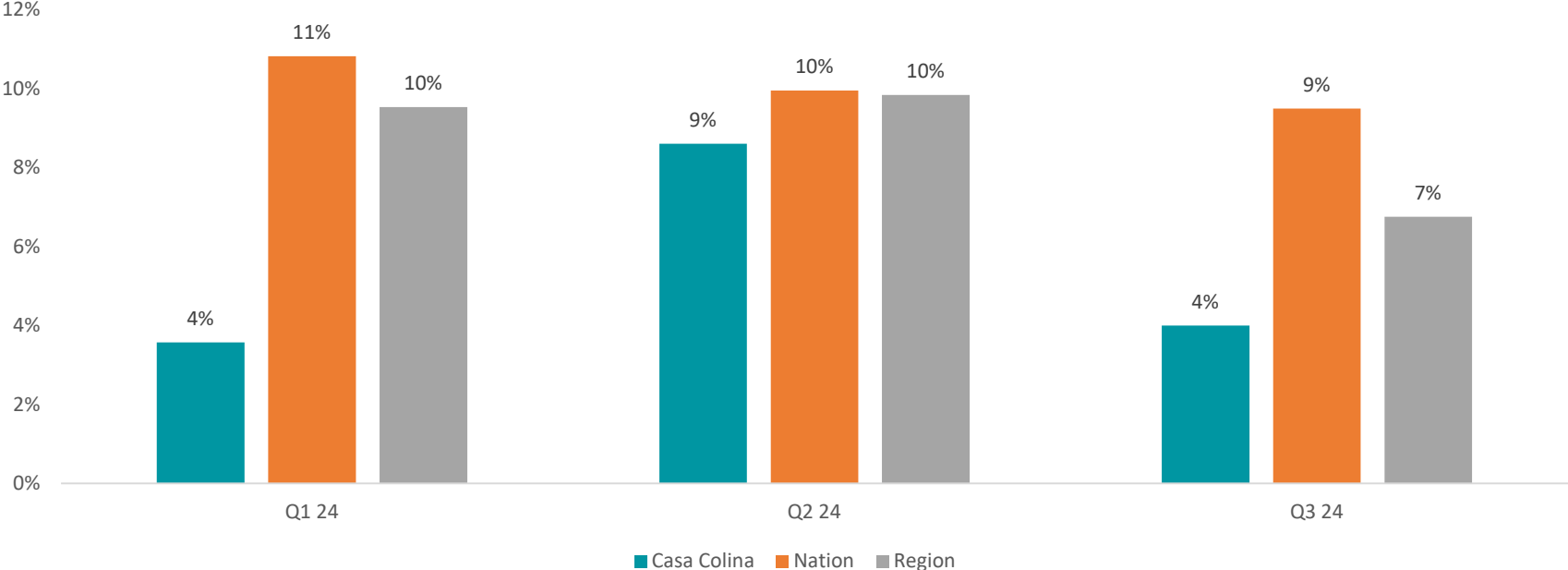


Stroke: Total Therapy Minutes Per Day

Acute Rehabilitation Unit – Stroke Patient Outcomes 2024 (3 months post discharge)

Over 75% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge

Patients with a stroke were satisfied or highly satisfied with these aspects of care:	Q1 2024	Q2 2024	Q3 2024
Overall satisfaction with their rehabilitation stay	98%	100%	100%
Social activities are the same or better than before their rehabilitation stay	56%	79%	61.5%
Decision making during their rehabilitation stay	98%	91%	86%
Rehabilitation prepared patients to return home	98%	100%	91%
Progress made met expectations	98%	96%	89%
Rehabilitation program improved their quality of life	100%	96%	100%
