Patients receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge.

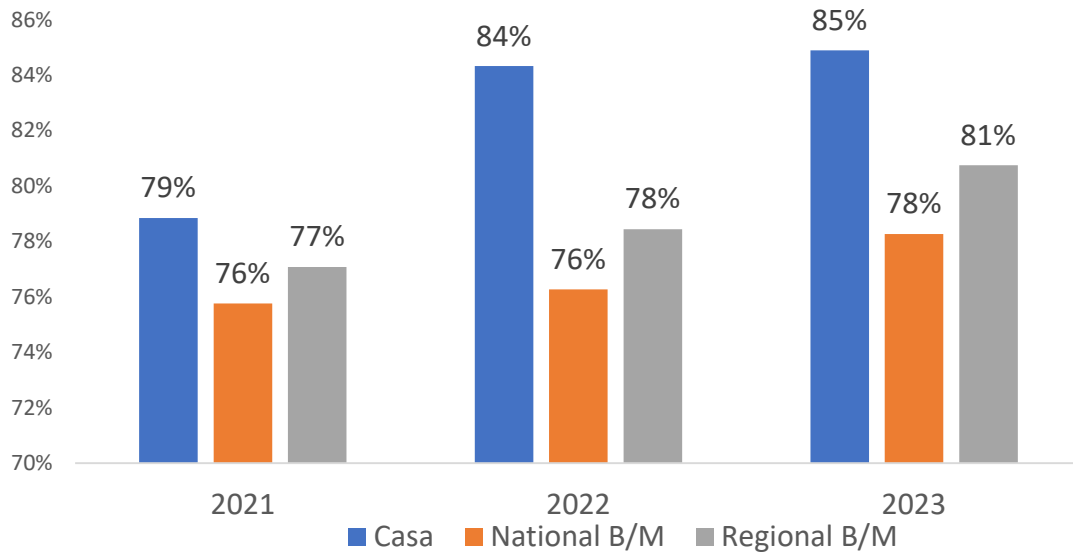
Over 82% of all inpatients return to the community at discharge

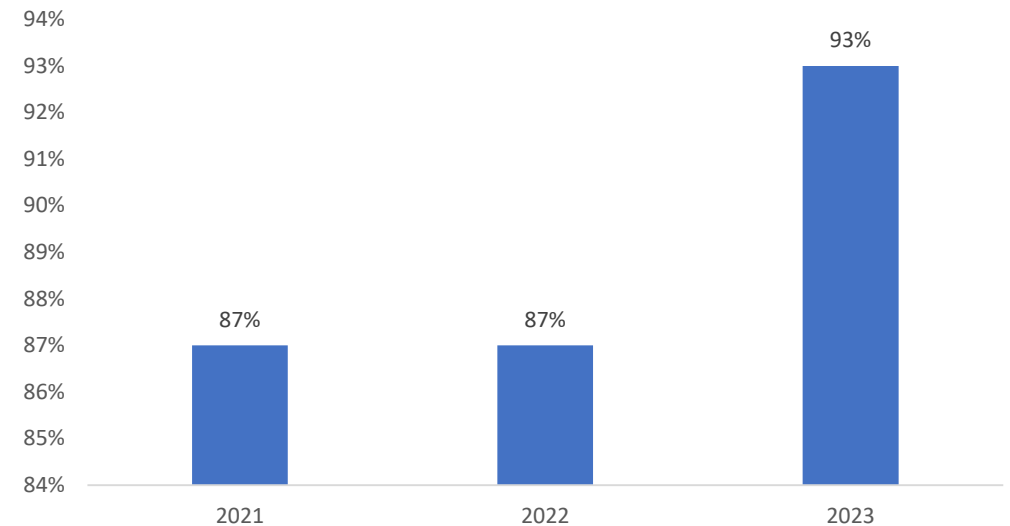
89% of all inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge

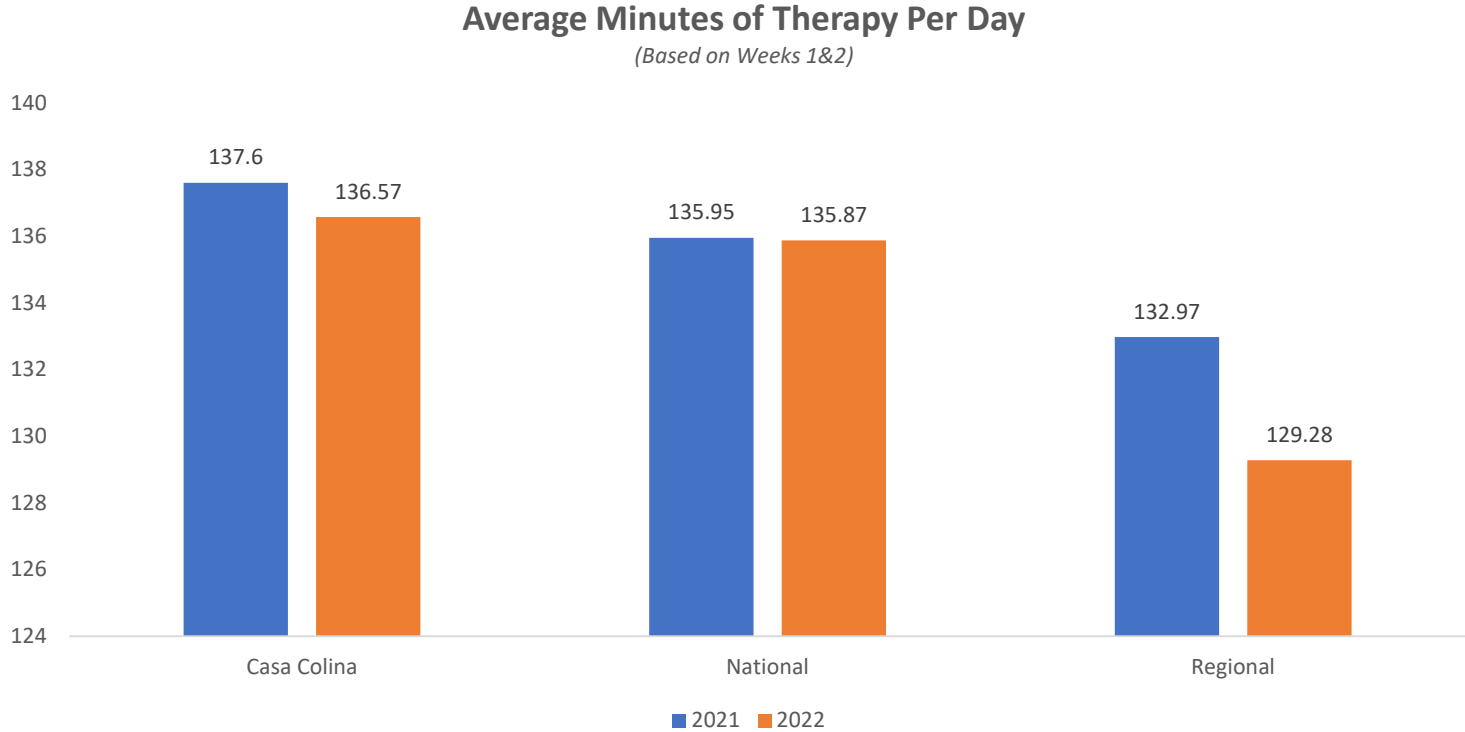
Rehab Unit Patients



Living in Community 3 months

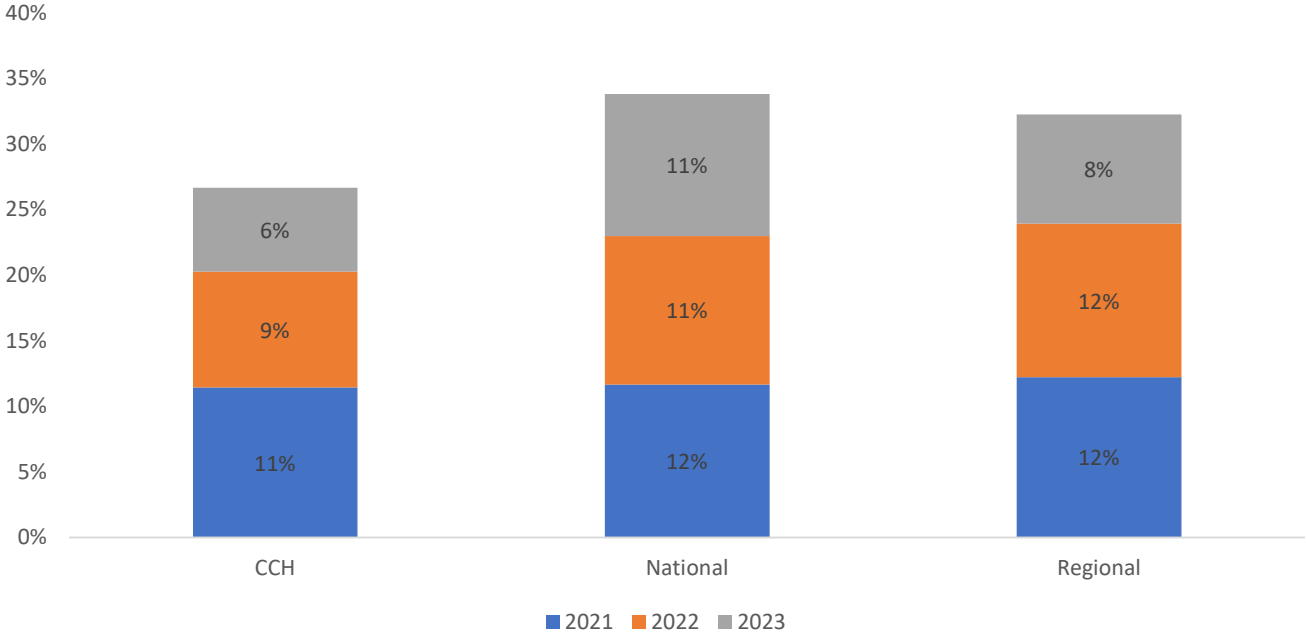


Casa Colina provides an average of 137 minutes of therapy per day; more than other programs around the country

Acute Rehabilitation Unit – Patient Outcomes 2023

(3 months post discharge)

Over 75% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge
