


Patients with a brain injury receive high quality medical and rehabilitation services, allowing them to return home, and stay home, after discharge.



82% of inpatients remain in the community 3 months after discharge



All Brain Injury Living in Community 3 months






Casa Colina provides an average of 133 minutes of therapy per day; 98% individual minutes for persons with Brain Injury



Individual Therapy Minutes Per Day




Total Therapy Minutes per day

Acute Rehabilitation Unit - Brain Injury Patient Outcomes 2023

(3 months post discharge)

Over 76% of patients receive continued therapy after discharge

Patients with a brain injury were satisfied or highly satisfied with these aspects of care:	2023
Overall satisfaction with their rehabilitation stay	98%
Social activities are the same or better than before their rehabilitation stay	76%
Decision making during their rehabilitation stay	87%
Rehabilitation prepared patients to return home	93%
Progress made met expectations	92%
Rehabilitation program improved their quality of life	94%
